2020 - Mainport sells Mainport Kells.



2020 - Mainport buys survey ship OYA and renames her Mainport Geo.



2020 - Mainport sets up Mainport Med. Buys ROV and survey vessel Vega Uno



2019 - Maas Capital sell 49% holdings in Mainport Seismic Holdings. Ships and charters transferred to Mainport Seismic Support Limited.



2018 - Celtic Tugs sells Celtic Banner and replaces her with Celtic Fergus.



2016 - Lisheen last ship worked for export of zinc, after 14 years.



2015 - Oil price plummet seismic support industry contracts, so company sells Mainport Oak, Ash and Elm to scrap.



2016 - Mainport buys large chase boat Mainport Kells.



2014 - Seahorse sells MV Pearl and replaces with Ocean Spey,



2014 - James Scott Shannon Foynes dockers rationalisation last phase implimented.



2013 - Sell our interest in Caspian Mainport Offshore, but continue to provide management for co. renamed CMI.



2013 - Sets up new JV with Maas Capital of ABN bank to form Mainport Seismic Holdings ltd.

2014 - Two new ships, Mainport Pine and Mainport Cedar, commence 7 year charter.



2012 - Mainport wins long term contract to provide 2 new seismic support ships; built in Malaysia.



2010 - Mainport buys 3 Seacor AHTS and renames Mainport Oak, Ash and Elm. Ships work in different parts of the world on mid-term charters.
